Colorado Association for School-Based Health Care (CASBHC) is a nonprofit organization with the mission to *optimize health and academic achievement among young people through access to quality, integrated health care in schools*. CASBHC advances health and educational equity through advocacy, technical assistance, and professional development for existing and emerging school-based health centers (SBHCs).

- More than 38,000 students receive primary care, behavioral health, and oral health services annually in 63 SBHCs in Colorado.
- In 2019, CASBHC secured over \$6.2 million in funds distributed directly to SBHCs, and contributed another \$1 million of in-kind support including training and professional development, technical assistance, advocacy, and growing the number of SBHCs. Member organizations were able to participate as CASBHC's sub-grantees on grants totaling over \$200,000.
